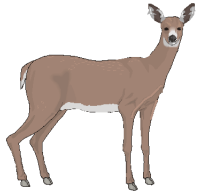


About the Cataraqui Trail

The Cataraqui Trail is a former rail line that has been converted into a multi-use trail. Walking, cycling, horseback riding, cross-country skiing and snowmobiling are permitted uses.

The thriving railway was a lifeline connecting mining, farming and logging communities between Napanee and Smiths Falls a century ago.



In 1997 CN donated most of the rail bed to the Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority. The CRCA formed a management board representing landowners,

municipalities and trail users to develop, maintain and promote the trail.

The management board's responsibilities include finding funds and volunteers to help operate and maintain the trail.

We Need Your Support

Government funding is not provided for the maintenance and operation of recreational trails like this one. We depend on the community for our financial support.

For the Bike and Hike you can collect donations and pledges or pay \$40 per family, \$25 per adult or \$10 per child under 18. This includes a barbecue lunch at Chaffey's Locks Community Hall.

Not interested in biking or hiking? Tickets for the wagon ride and lunch are \$30.00 per person.

Charitable Receipts

Wagon ride tickets are not eligible for a tax receipt.



Cataraqui Trail Bike and Hike Routes

Choose from one of the following cycling routes.

13 km family cycle - meet at 11:00 a.m. at the Chaffey's Locks Community Hall. Cycle west on Opinicon Road and join the trail at Indian Lake Road. Go eastward, over the bridge and through woods and wetlands to Chaffey's Lock Road and return.



37 km cycle - meet at 10:15 a.m. at Perth Road and the Cataraqui Trail (County Rd. 10 just north of Perth Road Village). Cycle along the trail to Chaffey's Locks for lunch and return.

33 km cycle - meet at 10:15 a.m. at Kin Park on Harlem Road in Portland. Cycle along the trail to Chaffey's Locks for lunch and return.

(Note - The trail has a gravel surface. Bikes with a 2 inch minimum tire width are recommended.)

5 km hike - meet at 11:00 a.m. at the Chaffey's Locks community hall. Walk past the locks on Opinicon Road. Take the path to the old passenger shelter on the Cataraqui Trail. Go over the Rideau Canal bridge and return to Chaffey's Locks.



Wagon Rides

Wagon rides depart at 10:45 a.m. from Perth Road and from Kin Park in Portland and end in Chaffey's Locks.

Reservations are required by calling (613) 546-4228 ext. 221 or 1-877-956-CRCA (2722) ext. 221. Payment of \$30.00 per person is required when you register.

Rest Stop and Lunch

A BBQ lunch will be served at the Chaffey's Locks Community Hall, where there will also be a silent auction. Washrooms are also located here.
